
Badaboom! This cleverly camouflaged kitchen is almost invisible to the naked eye.

Within the framework of remodeling work on the former Werzer cinema in Pörtlach, the roof was opened up in order to make space for a large extension. The apartment has a floor area of 250 square meters and serves as a holiday home for a family of seven. The light floors, comfortable gray tones and white surfaces create a harmonious atmosphere. The living area is located at the heart of the apartment, together with the so-called "Camouflage Kitchen", also designed by the architects. Clad with eternit panels, the kitchen is crowned with a floating light element. Comfortable children's bedrooms, a guest room, and the ensuite parents' bedroom are all grouped around the living area. The design concept is inspired by structures, textures and dynamic roof landscapes.
